The West Windsor-Plainsboro Regional School District can report that the hiring process for Class III Special Law Enforcement Officers has been completed by Plainsboro and West Windsor Townships. Class III Police Officers are retired police officers hired specifically to work within township public schools. The officers have completed interviews, thorough background investigations, physical examinations and psychological evaluations, and will complete a comprehensive training program, including all state-mandated training before beginning their duties within WW-P Schools.

Please note the following:

- Plainsboro Township. The Plainsboro Township Police Department has completed the hiring process for three Class III Special Law Enforcement Officers. Officers have met with school administrations at High School North and Community Middle School and completed several building walk-through opportunities with supervising officers. The new officers will begin working in schools during the week of Feb. 11, 2019.
- West Windsor Township. The West Windsor Township Police Department has completed the hiring process to add its fourth Class III Officer to join WW-P. Currently, two officers are working at High School South and one officer is working at Dutch Neck Elementary School. The new officer will begin work at Grover Middle School during the week of Feb. 11, 2019.
