### **School News**

#### **CMS Back to School Nights**

- Back to School Night (BSTN) is your opportunity to see your child's teachers, learn about our curricular programs, purchase CMS Pantherwear, and receive information about other community activities. This year, BSTN is from 6:15-8:08 p.m. for all three grade levels. Your child will bring home a special schedule for you to follow these evenings:
  - Grade 6 – Tuesday, Sept. 24
  - Grade 7 – Wednesday, Sept. 25
  - Grade 8 – Thursday, Sept. 26
  - Please note that BSTN is for parents and guardians only. We will have our student leaders to help and guide you throughout the building.
- For Back to School Night (BSTN), the CMS PTSA is also collecting items for the Plainsboro Food Pantry. Feel free to bring in items for your grade level and drop off items in the donation box in the front lobby:
  - 6th Grade BSTN, Tuesday, Sept. 24: body lotion, shampoo/conditioner, and toilet paper
  - 7th Grade BSTN, Wednesday, Sept. 25: body soap/body wash, laundry detergent, and paper towels
  - 8th Grade BSTN, Thursday, Sept. 26: sanitary pads/tampons, adult diapers (women), cleaning solutions, and household sponges

### **After School Activities**

- Please make sure your child tells you that they are staying after school. If your child is staying after school, they must be supervised by a staff member. Late Buses are available at 4:15 p.m.
- Your child should know their [Late Bus Letter](#), as late bus stops are not the same as morning and afternoon bus stops. A late bus map is available and if your child needs additional assistance, your child should know their address to tell the late bus supervisor.
- The code of conduct applies to all after school activities, bus rides, and bus stops.
- If you are picking up your child from an after school activity, please park your car in a lined parking spot in the main parking lot. Do not park in the fire lane or double park in the front loop.

### **Drop-Off/Pick-Up Reminders**

- If driving your child to school:
  - Please note that students **cannot be dropped off before 7:05 a.m.**, unless they are participating in a particular program or event.
  - Student drop-offs occur in the front loop of the main building. Do not drop off your child in the main parking lot or on Grovers Mill Road. Do not double park or pass other cars to drop off your child.

- For everyone's safety, please obey all one-way signs and yield to school buses that are exiting the main parking lot.
- Plainsboro Police will enforce all traffic laws on Grovers Mill Road and on CMS property.
- If picking up your child from school:
  - **Regular dismissal is 2:46 p.m.**, please park your car in the main parking lot or remain in your car in the front loop of CMS.
  - If you are picking up your child before dismissal, please make sure your child brings in a note to the main office during arrival.
  - If you are picking up your child before dismissal, please park your car in a designated parking spot in the front of the building. Do not leave your car unattended in the fire lane. You must bring your driver's license to the security desk before picking up your child.
  - For everyone's safety, please obey all one-way signs and yield to school buses that are exiting the main parking lot.
  - Plainsboro Police will enforce all traffic laws on Grovers Mill Road and on CMS property.

### **Payment/Forms and Documents**

- If your child is handing in money, forms, or a note to the main office, their teacher, nurse's office or Food Services, please make sure your child's name is written on the front of an envelope.

### **Reminders from CMS Nurses**

- If your child takes medication during school hours and/or for emergencies, please bring in the medication and doctor's orders to the Nurses' Office.
- 6th graders must have their TDAP and Meningococcal vaccines in order to attend school.
