
Important Dates and Times

Middle School Club/Activities Information:

Please make sure your child listens to the daily announcements for information pertaining to any after-school clubs and activities. We have late buses that leave CMS at 4:15 p.m. and 5:30 p.m.
Monday through Friday. Your child must know the <u>late bus letter</u> he or she has to take as the late buses do not drop off at the numbered bus stops. Please make sure your child knows his or her address and phone number before you give them permission to stay after school.



- The first day of school for students is **Thursday, September 5**th, and your sixth grader may be anxious about class locations and lockers, but all our sixth graders <u>will report to the auditorium as soon as they arrive to the building</u>. There we will have our first administrative assembly and our sixth grade team teachers will meet their students. Please make sure your sixth grader knows **the last name of their Period 1 teacher**. This teacher is your child's homeroom teacher and they will have a hard copy of your child's schedule on the first day of school.
- For the first day of school, please do not have your child purchase and bring all of their school supplies for the first day of school. Allow your child's teachers to identify the essential supplies from our <u>CMS school supply list</u>. In addition, please do not buy an oversized backpacks. Our lockers vary in sizes and oversized backpacks will not fit in some of our lockers.
 - **Helpful Hints for Students:** Lockers will vary in location, so do not plan to go to lockers between each period. Get to know where your teachers post homework so that can be shared with your parents. Label all of your belongings with your name, and make sure everything is locked in your hallway and Physical Education lockers!
- Please note that we will have breakfast and lunch for purchase at CMS. If you want to place money on your child's <u>lunch account</u> or view the <u>monthly lunch menu</u>, please go to the district website or have your child give money to our cafeteria manager, Mr. Al Bossio.
- We want to keep all our students safe and healthy while at CMS. Please review with your child the <u>CMS 2019-2020 Student Handbook/Code of Conduct</u> so you can reiterate our expectations of being a student at CMS.
- Please make sure all emergency contact numbers and health records are updated. Please call our school nurses, Ms. Michelle Decker and Ms. Kathryn Johnson, if there are any concerns pertaining to your child's health. We have a number of students and staff members with severe allergies and we are using specific health alert signs as well as reviewing safety procedures with our staff and students. Please refrain from bringing in food or drink that contain ingredients, such as peanuts, tree nuts, milk or eggs, for the safety of our staff and students.
