ACT	SAT
3 Hours 25 minutes (w/Essay)	3 Hours 50 minutes (w/Easy)
Question formats are more straightforward	Questions align more closely with curriculum
Tests knowledge gained in school	Taught in school
Time per question is quicker but less complex	No sentence completion questions
