Softball Cooperative Sport Proposal

NJSIAA By-Laws for Cooperative Sports Program

The purpose of a Cooperative Sports Program is to provide opportunities for participation when none would otherwise exist, as for instance when a school lacks a particular program or when a school has declining enrollment in a particular program.

Under no circumstances is a CSP to be used for purposes of creating a stronger or more competitive team, or as an excuse for eliminating an otherwise viable athletic program.

Primary Purpose for the Cooperative Softball Program

1. Declining participation numbers

2. Safety Concerns due to player lack of experience

- 2021- A and B Team at the middle school level
 - Teaching fundamentals skills to novice players
