New Courses and a New Department for 2022-2023

- Dance
- Photography II
- Emerging Financial Markets

3 NEW

Dance

- New Department - with the creation of dance studios in HSS and HSN
 - Students in grades 9-12
 - 5 credits YR

- Dance 1 - new course
 - Performance based for all levels
 - Students will create and choreograph dance
 - Genres include:
 - Ballet; contemporary; jazz; hip-hop; and additional styles from around the world

Photography II

- New Course - (prerequisite: Photography I or Portfolio Review)
 - Students in grades 10-12
 - 5 credits
 - Further development of:
 - Student capacity to produce professional work
 - Advanced exposure to possibilities available within the field
 - Creative voice
 - Darkroom techniques and processes
 - Film and presentation formats
 - Lighting techniques
 - Digital manipulation options

Emerging Financial Markets

➤ New Course

- Students in grades 9-12
- Prerequisite: Introduction to Computer Programming
- 5 credits: YR
- Focuses on:
 - The principles of digital finance
 - How cryptocurrencies are designed, built, and valued
 - Blockchain technologies
 - Investment strategies in emerging markets
 - Digital financial security.
 - Changing landscapes of finance

Revisions to the POS for 2022-2023

- Pre-Calculus H&A and Honors merge to Honors
 - This necessitated a change to AP Calculus BC eligibility to include Pre-Calculus Honors
 - Small change to Geometry H&A as it will now be the culminating H&A course

- Option ii deadline - moved up a month to April 1st.
