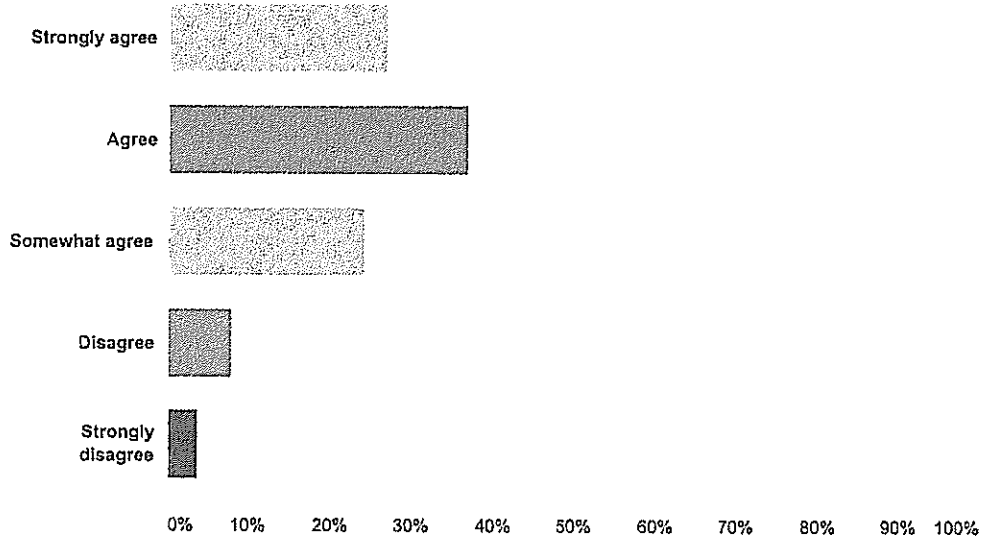

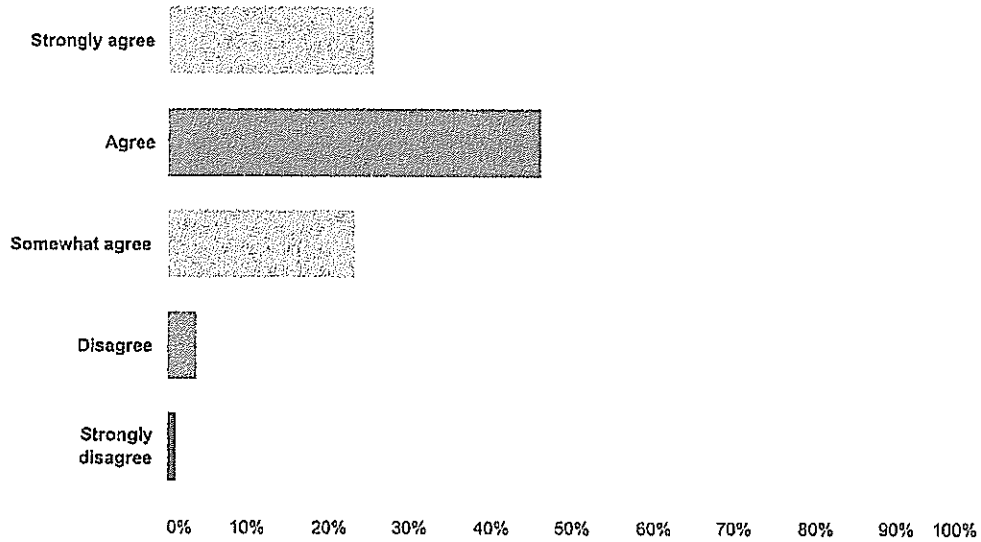

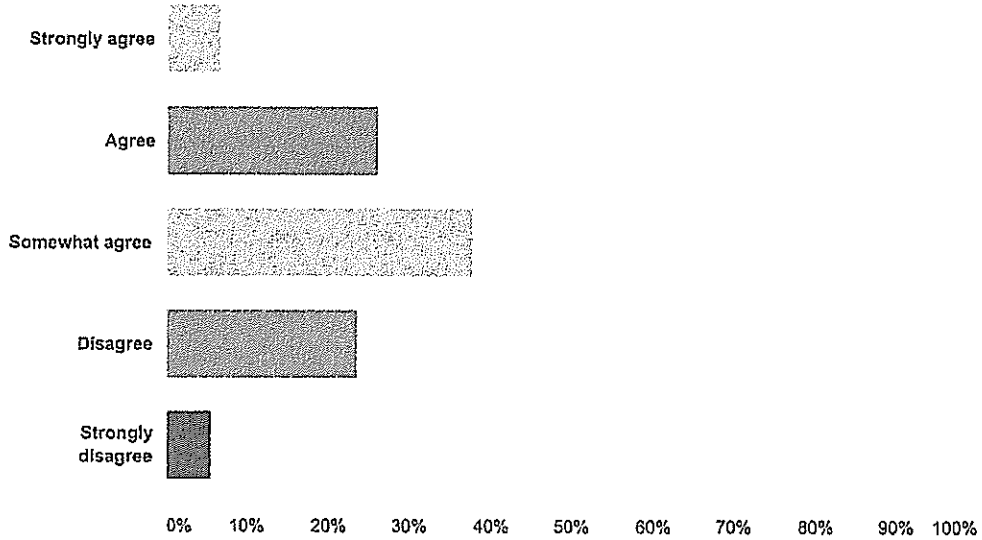

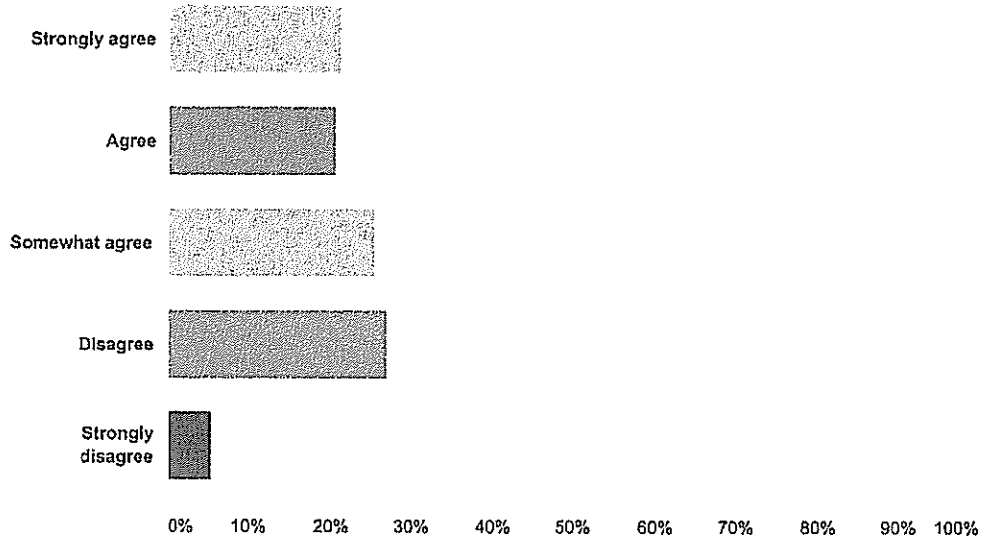

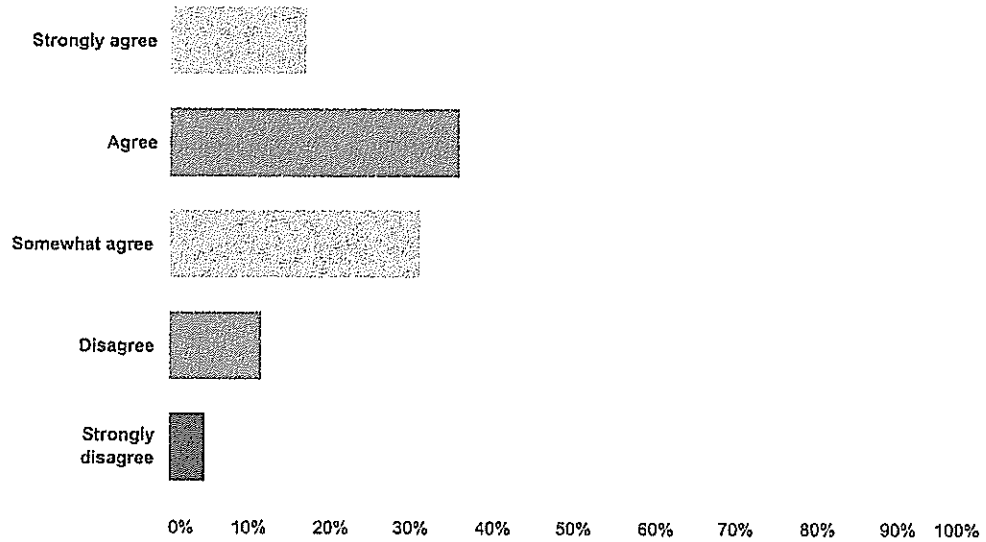

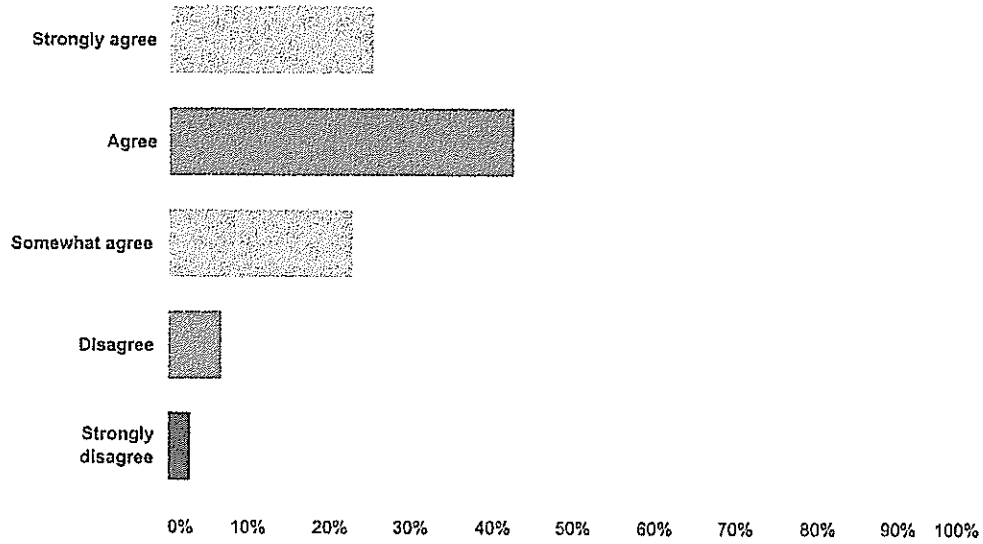

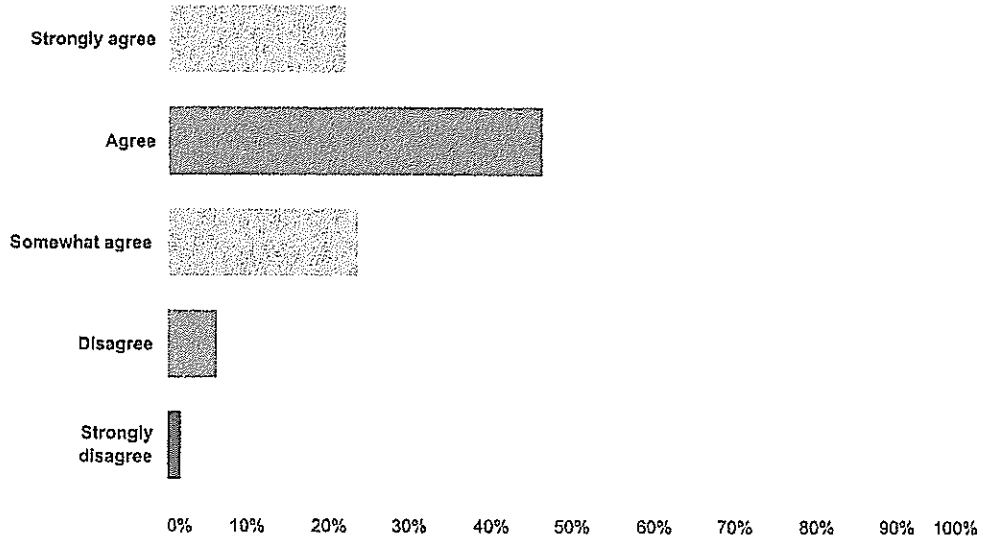

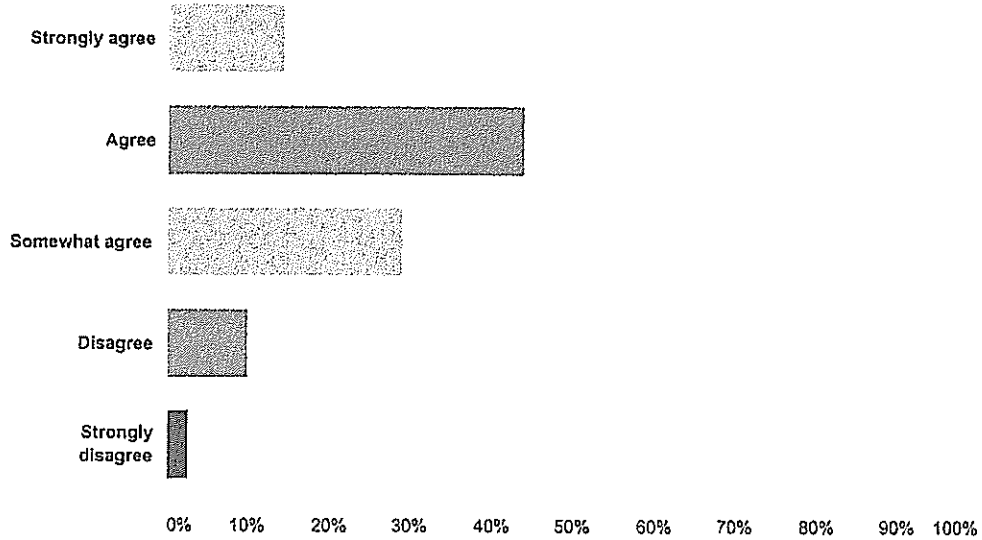

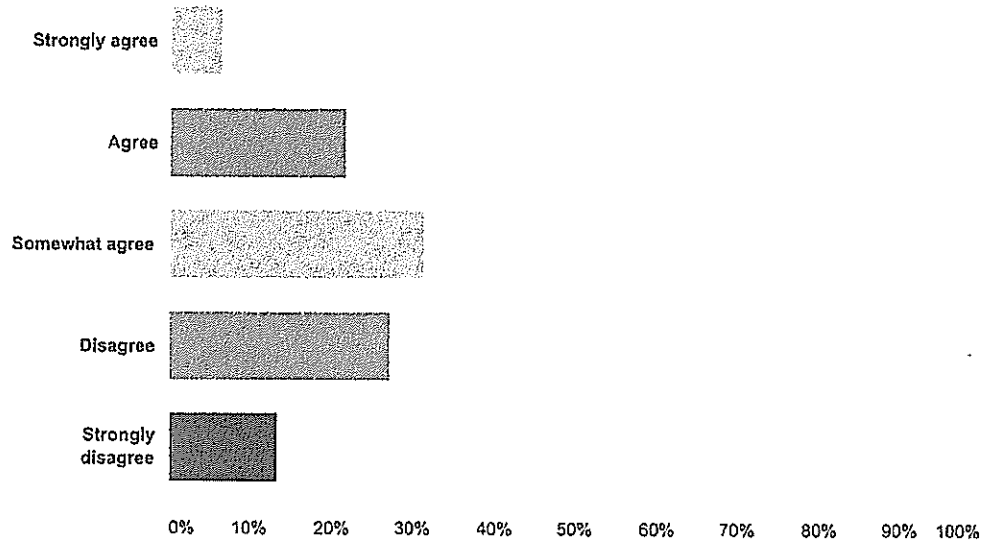

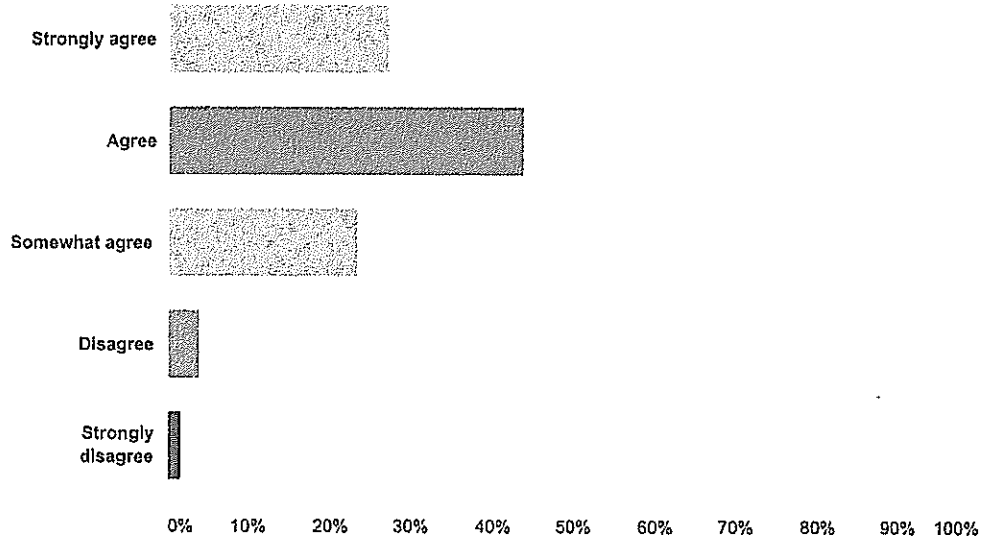

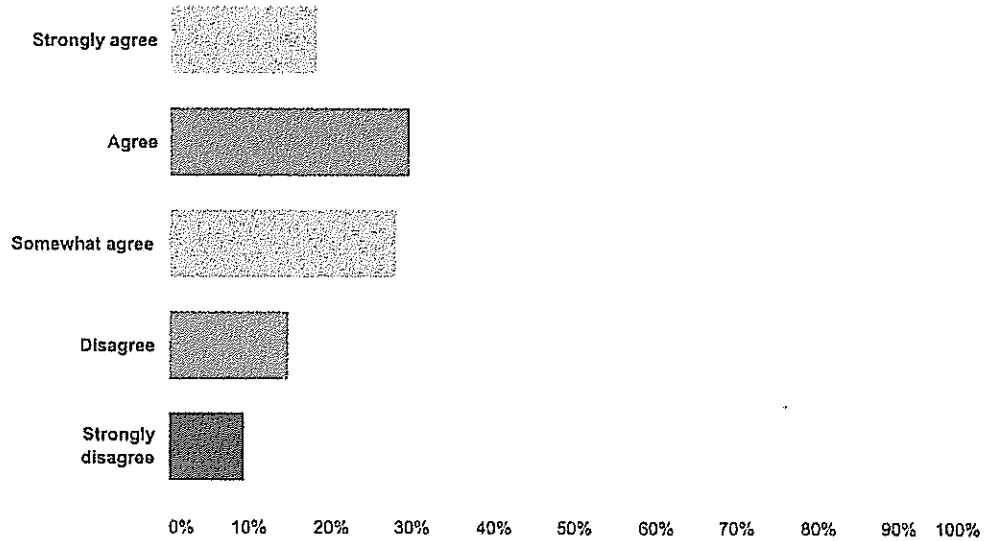

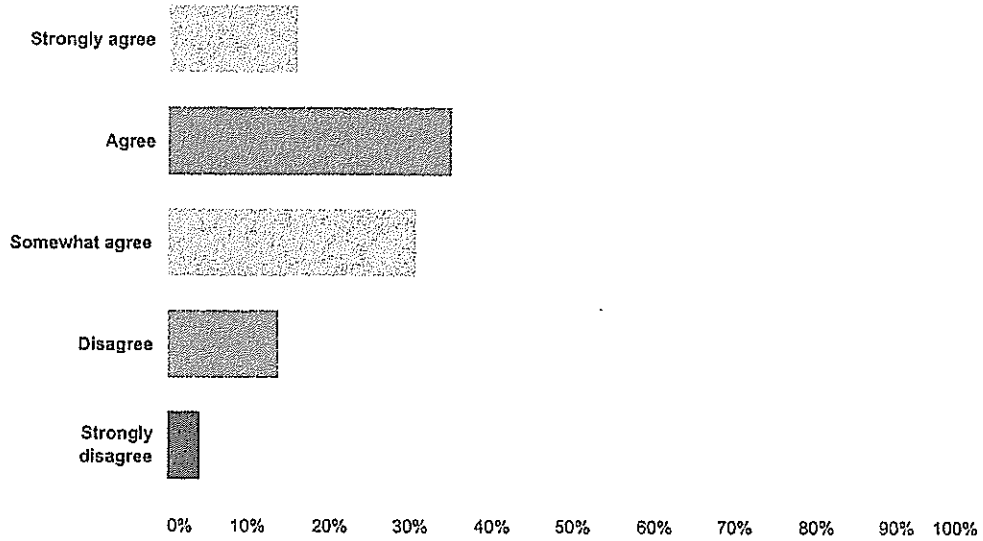

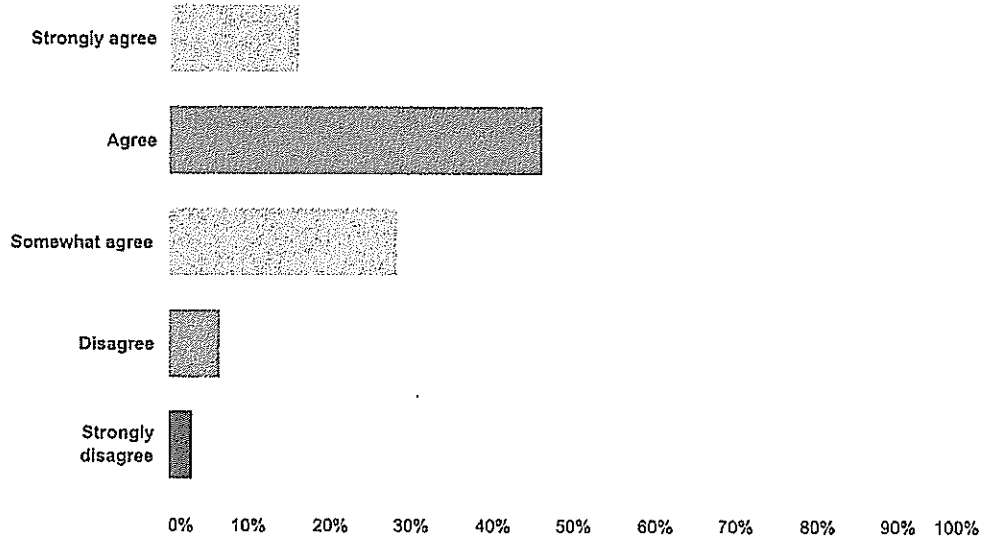

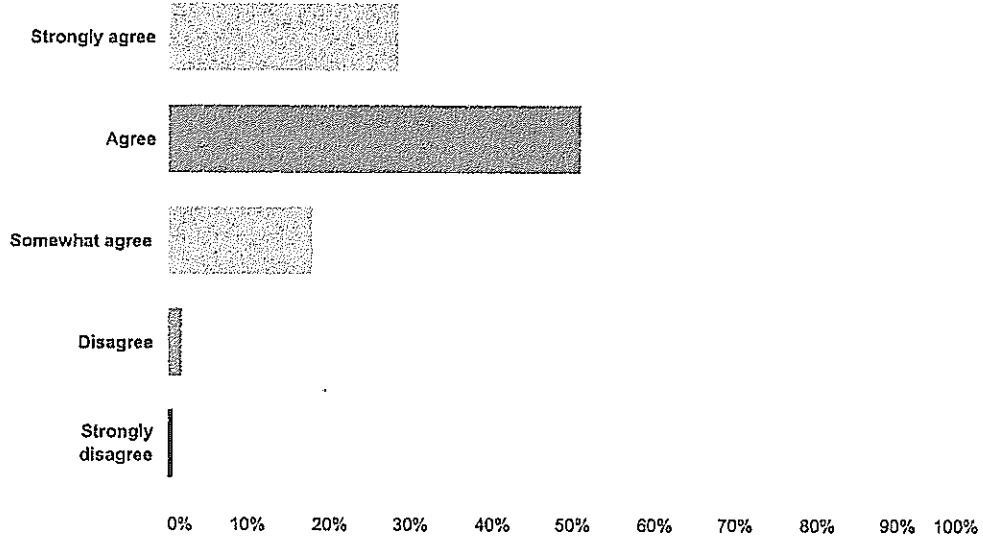

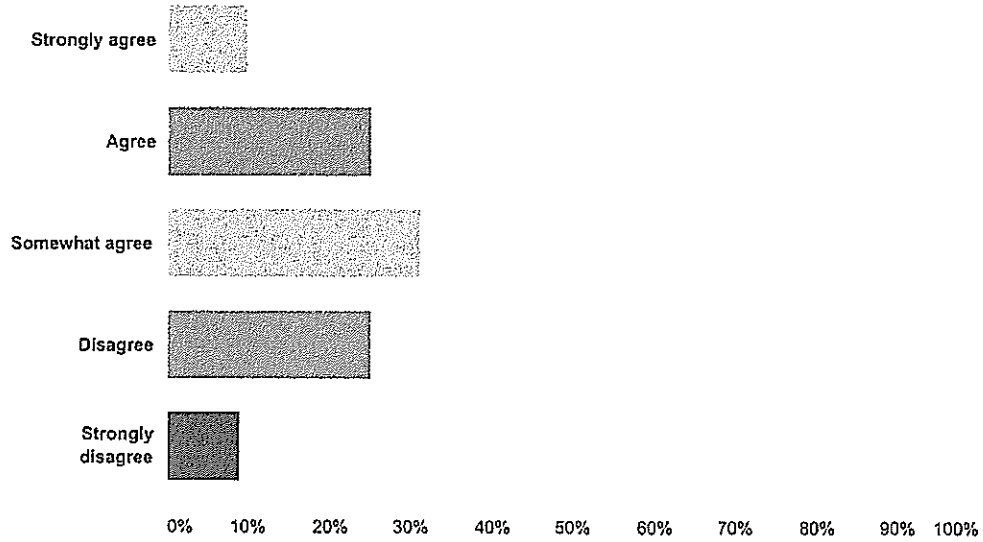

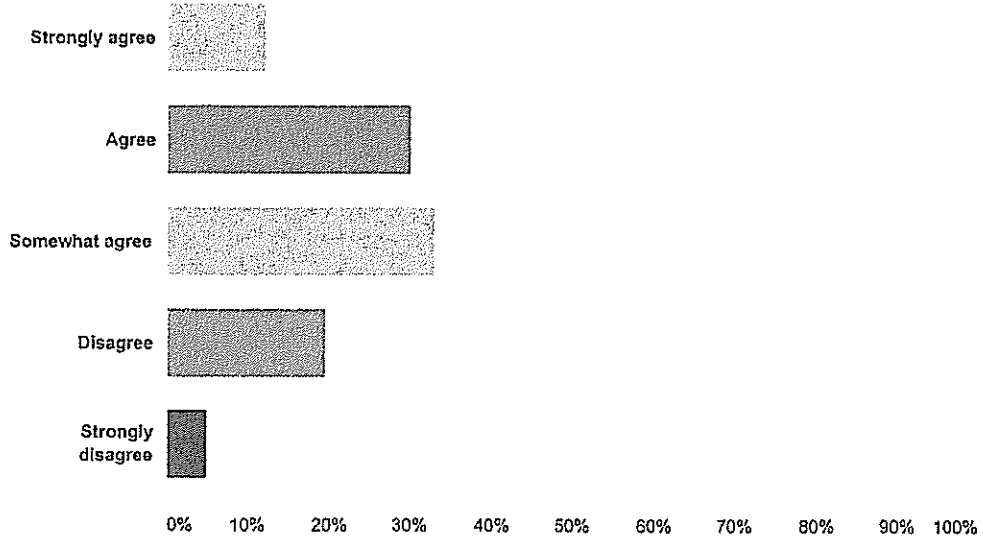

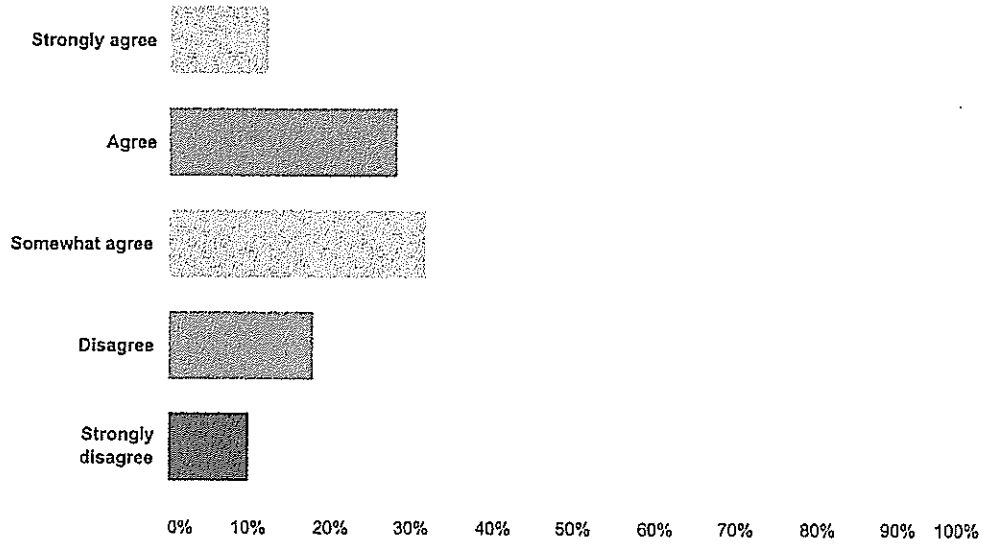

However, I fully understand that sometimes the district has to make decisions and changes based on other circumstances. Again, I understand that sometimes other, unknown circumstances cause changes. However, the district should be able to defend their decisions with viable data and a strong rationale.
